Firstly, an appreciation to **Cyril & Jean Hawes**, for all the work & time spent in growing the hall bookings & keeping a healthy line of communication with what was the North Shore & is now the Auckland Council. We wish them both a happy retirement in Whangarei.

We have updated the Okura hall booking fees & wish to persuade all 'Okura catchment residents' to become fully paid up members of Okura Residents Association (only \$10/year per household, \$5/year for retirees), so as to benefit from a 25% discount when hiring the main hall (including the kitchen) or the smaller function room. Can be paid via internet banking to Okura ratepayers and residents society Inc 38-9008-0840371-00.

The Auckland Council are happy with the way the hall/field/playground are being cared for by the ORRA committee, & are willing & able to continue with ongoing improvements within the next weeks/months – such as: replacing paper towels with hand dryers in the toilets; purpose built fire exit pathway; additions to the playground. (A new water pump + 2 water filters have been installed, making the water safe to drink at all times).

Please keep a look out for any suspicious behaviour involving illegal fishing in the Marine Reserve. A \$200,000 fine for breaking this law can result. No need for a confrontation, just note the registration of vehicle & a phone call to any committee member, or the local police 4775000.




